



## Interleague Cup 2020

The format for the interleague KO Cup for 2020 will be as follows:

11am: 2 prelim matches (2 losers of these matches will then go in with the 4 Q-Finals losers to play for 5<sup>th</sup> - 10<sup>th</sup>)

12.30pm: Q-Finals

***The rest of the times in this document are estimates only, and matches will be played earlier wherever possible.***

2pm: Semi-Finals (1<sup>st</sup> - 4<sup>th</sup>)

2pm: 3 x matches (5<sup>th</sup> - 10<sup>th</sup>) - made up of the 4 Q-final losing teams and the 2 prelim losing teams. The three winners of these matches will play for 5<sup>th</sup> - 7<sup>th</sup>.

The three losers of these matches will play for 8<sup>th</sup> - 10<sup>th</sup>.

3.30pm: Final (1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup>)

3.30pm: 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> place playoff

3.30pm: first group of three match - 1 v 3 (5<sup>th</sup> - 7<sup>th</sup>) ***Played on three tables***

3.30pm: first group of three match - 1 v 3 (8<sup>th</sup> - 10<sup>th</sup>) ***Played on three tables***

4.30pm: second group of three match - 2 v 3 (5<sup>th</sup> - 7<sup>th</sup>) ***Played on three tables***

4.30pm: second group of three match - 2 v 3 (8<sup>th</sup> - 10<sup>th</sup>) ***Played on three tables***

5.30pm: third group of three match - 1 v 2 (5<sup>th</sup> - 7<sup>th</sup>) ***Played on three tables***

5.30pm: third group of three match - 1 v 2 (8<sup>th</sup> - 10<sup>th</sup>) ***Played on three tables***

All matches will finish once one team has won 10 frames. If a match is a 9-9 draw, a 3 person simultaneous playoff will take place to decide the winner.

In the groups of 3 (5<sup>th</sup> - 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> - 10<sup>th</sup>), there will be no draws, and if a match reaches 9-9, it will also result in a 3-person simultaneous playoff to decide the winner. It will be one point for a win. If teams are tied, places will be decided on frame difference.

The TD reserves the right to play any match on more than 2 tables if it helps the running of the competition. This can be decided upon mid-match if any matches are affecting timings of the competition.

Prelim matches will start at 11am. Q-Final matches will start at 12.30pm. Per section 2, point 7 of the interleague rules, frames will be claimed if a player is not ready to play after 10mins grace. So, please make sure your team is ready to start matches on time, or you will fall foul of this ruling.

The draw for the prelims at 11am will be drawn on Sunday 8th March, at the Cambs County matches with the help of at least 1 other CPA officer. All teams will be notified of this draw on the evening of the 8th March.
